Background and Objectives

Vidyabhyasa Vikasa Kendram (VVK) Kochi in collaboration with Centre for Earth Research and Environment Management, (CEREM), Kochi and MES Training college, Aluva is organising a national conference on "Dwindling Resources: Sustainable Water management in Kerala with special reference to Groundwater on March 22-23, 2022. This event will coincide with World Water Day on 22 March 2022 under the theme Groundwater: Making the Invisible, Visible.

As is well known, State of Kerala with abundant rainfall and water resources in the form of rivers, lakes, ponds etc., is becoming more water scarce in recent times. Recurring floods and droughts in the state is affecting the water sector, with increasing scarcity across all sectors. This is more so in domestic sector which is dependent mostly on groundwater, which is highly disparate in availability and quality thereby widening the supply-demand gap. Most employed strategies are towards increasing supply than reducing the demand, resulting in further exploitation and over drafts of water. Experience shows that existing strategies need a relook and revamp on water governance, management, and policies. In this context, citizens, through increased awareness play a major role in judicious management of available water, contribute towards protection, conservation as well as substance for safeguarding this valuable resource for generations to come.

This two-day conference aims to understand the status of water resources in the State to seek sustainable solutions to combat ever increasing crisis. We expect participation of a wide range of stakeholders including students, water professionals, teachers, scientists and public. This would be a platform to share the knowledge, experiences, findings, and some good practices. Also, this helps to elaborate recommendation for overall improvement in water sector thereby integrating into Sustainable development Goals of the State/Nation.

- 2. Impact of hydrological extremes on water resources under changing climate
- 3. Groundwater development and management: Issues, Challenges, Gaps, and solutions

Abstract and paper should be submitted in Times Roman Font 12 points with proper headings in Bold and Subsections underlined format. Abstract should have 5-6 key words. Tables and figures properly numbered along the text. References in APA format. Word limit -min, 1500 and maximum 3500.

Publication

Accepted manuscripts are proposed to be published as full-length research papers in an Edited Volume. Full length paper to be submitted on or before 22/3/2022.

Best Oral/Poster presentation would be awarded with Certificate of Appreciation.
